Class Format: There will be tests as indicated on the schedule below. Up to the first fifteen minutes of each class will be spent reviewing assigned homework problems. Unless a test is scheduled, there will next be a quiz, and then new material will be covered.

Requirements: You are allowed three absences. Leaving class early will be counted as half an absence. You will be dropped from the class if you have more than three absences; however, if you stop attending, it is your responsibility to drop the class. All students remaining on the roster after April 9 must receive a letter grade. There will be no talking during class other than the class discussion. If your phone rings during class or if I see you text messaging or using the internet during class or if your electronic devices disrupt class in any other way, points will be deducted from your quiz total. Two points will be deducted for the first incident, 4 for the second, 8 for the third, and so on.

Academic Honesty: Cheating will not be tolerated. Anyone who plagiarizes someone else's work or uses resources that are not allowed on an assignment will receive a score of zero on that assignment. The resulting score of zero will not be dropped as a lowest quiz or test grade. Furthermore, every possible effort will be made to place that cheating incident in the student's permanent record.

There will generally be no calculators allowed for tests or quizzes. After dropping your two lowest quiz grades and one lowest test grade, scores will be counted as follows:
